**CALL FOR THE SUBMISSION OF STUDIES FOR
PUBLICATION IN THE SERIES
'ELECTRONIC PUBLICATIONS OF THE CHRISTIAN
ARCHAEOLOGICAL SOCIETY'**

Submission deadline: Friday, **30 October 2020**

In 2015, the Christian Archaeological Society (ChAE), in collaboration with the National Documentation Centre, created the series **Electronic Publications of the Christian Archaeological Society** (ChAE e-publications [e-books]), with the purpose to publish online, in open access, original scholarly monographs and edited volumes on topics of Byzantine and Post-Byzantine art and archaeology.

Continuing this series the Administrative Board of the ChAE at its last meeting decided to launch a call for the submission of monographs/edited volumes to be published in the open access series Electronic Publications of the Christian Archaeological Society (ChAE e-publications):

The submitted monograph/edited volume must be unpublished, original, and its subject should be relevant to Byzantine and Post-Byzantine archaeology and art. Monographs or edited volumes whose contents refer to monuments after 1830, will not be accepted.

The **length** of the submitted monograph/edited volume should be **around 150.000 words**, including footnotes, bibliography, summaries (abstract and summary) and the list of illustrations.

The submitted monograph/edited volume should follow the **Author guidelines**:

The text should be submitted in **one single file** (pdf and Word), **without mention of the name of the author(s) or editor(s)**, which will include the following in the order listed: **(i)** the title of the monograph/edited volume in Greek and in English; **(ii)** the 500-word abstract in Greek and in English; **(iii)** the keywords in Greek and in English; **(iv)** the text with the footnotes and the images inserted with their captions; **(v)** in the case of monographs written in Greek, the summary of 10 000 words in another language (English, French, German, Italian) and in the case of an edited volume, the summaries of up to 1000 words for each study; **(vi)** the bibliography; **(vii)** the list of illustrations and their credits (copyright).

In the case of monographs or edited volumes written in Greek, abstracts and summaries can be initially submitted in Greek; if the monograph or edited volume is approved for publication, then they must be submitted in another language.

Submitted monographs or edited volumes can be written in a language other than Greek and more specifically in English, French, German, or Italian. In this case, the monograph's summary should be in Greek. It is possible to submit the summary in the language in which the monograph or edited volume is written and, if the study is approved, to submit it in Greek.

The file should be sent electronically to the ChAE secretariat (chae1884@gmail.com). It should also be sent in printed form, in two (2) copies, to the Secretariat of the Christian Archaeological Society (Byzantine and Christian Museum, 22 Vassilissis Sophias Avenue, Athens GR-10675, with the indication 'for the *Electronic Publications of the ChAE*').

In addition to the above, in the case of monographs, a separate Word file should include the author's contact details and a short biographical note (up to 150 words). In the case of an edited volume, a separate Word file should include the contact details of the authors and a short biographical note (up to 80 words) for each author.

Submissions that fulfill the necessary requirements are forwarded anonymously to two (2) external reviewers who specialize in relevant fields and whose names are not disclosed. The reviewers evaluate the submitted manuscript on the basis of the following criteria:

- Originality
- Contribution to scholarship
- Structure and composition of text

Taking into consideration the outcome of the peer review process, the editorial board announces to authors/editors the acceptance (as they are or following some changes) or rejection of their studies. In cases of diverging evaluation, the monograph/edited volume is sent to a third reviewer. **The selection procedure shall not extend beyond six (6) months.**

Permission fees for the use of material in **electronic publications** whose copyright is held by third parties (whether institutions or individuals) are the author's sole responsibility. All other publication costs are incurred by the ChAE.

The deadline for the submission of the monographs/edited volumes is Friday, **30 October 2020**.


